The Grand Canyon Photography Club will hold its annual photo scavenger hunt on Tuesday, June 13th. Members should meet in front of the Gmeiner Art & Cultural Center in Wellsboro, PA at 7 p.m. (Rain date June 14th)

"We've held this event for several years," explained organizer Mia Lisa Anderson. "In the past we've searched for and photographed reflections, leading lines, light trails, and more. I thought it might be fun this time to change things up."

Members should bring their cameras (phone, DSLR, mirrorless-any type). The object of this hunt will be "The Alphabet." Club members will wander from the Gmeiner through downtown Wellsboro searching for



subjects that begin with the letters of the alphabet. For example, "S" could be a sign or a statue. "L" could be a lamp post or a leading line. Try to find as many of "the letters" of the alphabet as possible. Remember to incorporate good composition and lighting in your images. Be creative with your photography. The club member who photographs the most letters will win a prize.



All members are invited to submit their 5 best "alphabet" photos to Mia by June 30th. She will put together a slide show that can be presented at a later date.

"Have fun and enjoy this new twist on our hunt," said Mia. "Good luck."



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Darn it!

I forgot. I had your attention on how to prepare an image for our photo critiques. I showed you how I size my images to 2048 pixels on the long side, but I forgot to show you how to save the image with "Title and Your Name." So maybe this will help. Click "FILE" in the upper left-hand corner of the Adobe Elements workspace. Choose "SAVE AS" from the drop-down box.



A larger window will open in the work-space. Type your Title and Name in the space for "file name." Then you have to click on "PICTURES" so you can pick which folder to save the image in. (Before saving first make folders with the date and content in the folder's title.)

Click on "2022-09-29StonyFork" and then click on "SAVE." All safely saved. You can now go to that folder when you want to attach the image to an email to mialisa1957@gmail.com for that month's critique.

Here's hoping that one day we will have 100% participation in the critiques!


