There are many places to get your photographs "out there." I think the one that helped me the most is called '500 px.' It is a worldwide photo-sharing site. I got hooked about 10 years ago. I searched the "Great Wall of China" on the site and was impressed with the many wonderful images of that amazing structure. I was also impressed by the quality of many of the photos. If I liked something, I didn't just say "nice" or "beautiful." I tried to say what I liked about the photo. I thought I could learn how to make better photos if I could describe what I liked.
